The Hope Fund Calms the Chaos Caused by Hurricane Winds

When hurricanes hit, Ka<mark>thy Chav</mark>ez has learned, HCA Healthcare's Hope Fund is there to help.

Kathy, a senior product analyst, lives near New Orleans, La., and has sustained hurricane damage to her home by two different hurricanes over the past nine years.

She first learned about the Hope Fund in 2012 when a powerful hurricane damaged her roof and her homeowner's insurance wouldn't completely cover the necessary repairs.

Then, last fall, Hurricane Ida toppled a large tree onto the family's roof.

This damage, she says, was worse than the first time and the insurance company paid her only a fraction of the cost required for repairs. Again, the Hope Fund came through.

Kathy has "extreme gratitude" for the generosity of her colleagues who contribute from their paychecks to the Hope Fund.

"I know money is tight for a lot of people," she says, "and I am extremely grateful."

Hope Fund Assistance Helps Quell an 'Emotional Tornado.'

When health problems sidelined both Ida Montalvo and her husband, Guillermo, from their jobs in the neonatal intensive care unit (NICU), the HCA Healthcare Hope Fund stepped in to provide relief.

The struggles began when Ida's husband, Guillermo, the NICU's unit secretary, received a second cancer diagnosis in 2020, creating an "emotional tornado" for the couple, Ida says.

Guillermo's chemotherapy treatments make him extraordinarily weak and tired, and he had to miss quite a bit of work for a time.

In addition to Guillermo's illness and expensive treatments, Ida had gotten ill and had surgery.

"With all these (work) days that we missed, we were starting to drown a little," she says.

The Hope Fund threw out a lifeline.

"It's a wonderful blessing that we have here," Ida says, "that I think we don't recognize every day."





The Hope Fund Helped When a Major Health Crisis Occurred

Capelle Morgan is an HR Shared Services Coordinator who has worked with HCA Healthcare for six years. She has been contributing to the Hope Fund since shortly after she was hired, but never imagined needing it herself.

"I'm the primary caregiver for my mom Vicki who has a disability and heart problems. She recently had a health crisis which left her unable to talk or care for herself." Vicki was in the hospital for a month, and then in a nursing facility for another three weeks. Even after she returned home, she required in-home care for basic things like cooking, cleaning and taking care of herself. "That's not something insurance pays for, unfortunately." Capelle said.

Thankfully, Capelle remembered the Hope Fund from contributing for so many years. She decided to apply for help.

When she learned that she would be receiving assistance, she said, "It felt like a ton of bricks had been taken off my shoulders."

Capelle is so grateful for the assistance from her colleagues. She said, "You should never be afraid to ask for help. That's what the Hope Fund is there for. I know times are hard, but I really wish everybody would give even a dollar or two because you never know when you might find yourself in a position to ask for help."
